In the energy sector, Mesoamerica developed a Central American company alongside Actis, with operations in three countries and a generation capacity of +400 MW. In addition, alongside Actis, Mesoamerica developed Zuma Energía in Mexico, with a generation capacity of 800 MW in solar and wind energy.

Before founding Mesoamerica 20 years ago, Luis Javier was a consultant at Bain & Company. Luis Javier is one of the 100 more influential people in Latin America, according to América Economía.

In 2013, Luis Javier received the Businessman of the Year Award from El Financiero newspaper in Costa Rica due to his transcendent leadership, which allowed Mesoamerica to cross borders and become one of the most relevant and innovative companies of the last 20 years.

In 2019, he received the Businessman of the Year Award again for his work promoting quality education, sustainability, leadership innovation, gender equality and entrepreneurship in Costa Rica and Latin America through various social impact initiatives.
